

Reflecting on Jesus' Invitations Activity

Supplies Needed: 10+ post-its per participant

1. **5 mins:** Give everyone post-its and generate all the different kinds of invitations they are making in the ministry. Place these on a wall or table and ask someone to sort them as they arrive.
2. **5 mins:** In pairs, share what emotions you feel when you consider making all these invitations.
3. **2 mins:** Cast vision for why invitations matter. What might happen if we did them well and grew a healthy invitation culture in our community marked by joy and freedom — not guilt, obligation, and anxiety?
4. **5 mins:** Assign each pair one of the invitation passages above and ask them to think: what kind of invitation is Jesus giving? How would you describe the behaviors, attitudes, and beliefs the passage might teach about invitations?
5. **15 mins:** Have each pair share something they noticed.
6. **5 mins:** Invite people in pairs to share one thing about Jesus' Invitation Culture that resonates with them and how that may shape how they approach invitations on campus.
7. **5 mins:** Have each pair share briefly.
8. **5 mins:** Pray for each other.
