

# Faith & Chai: Leaders Guide

EVENT OUTLINE & SCRIPT

Here is an outline of the flow & potential script you can use for facilitating a Faith and Chai gathering. Modify it to fit your needs, we hope this helps you feel prepared and confident!

### Welcome

Welcome to Faith and Chai! Thank you for coming tonight. Faith is an important part in many of our lives, including my own, and I'm excited for us to be together to listen and learn how faith impacts each of us.

#### Introduction

The goal of Faith and Chai is to be a space for South Asian students to gather and respectfully dialogue about our faith and its influence in our lives. Tonight isn't about debate or arguing but rather listening and learning.

We hope you'll gain three things tonight:

- 1. Learn from one another—regardless of your faith background, we hope you learn something about how someone experiences the world through the lens of their faith.
- 2. Build new friendships
- 3. Consider new ways faith or spirituality might play a role in your life.

# Ground Rules

With that in mind, here are a few ground rules to help us get the most out of our discussions:

- 1. We are here as individuals, not as official spokespersons of a particular faith. Some people's views may represent the beliefs of a certain religion and others may not.
- 2. We don't have to agree, but let's do our best to respect each other even if we disagree.
- 3. There is a set of discussion questions in the bowl in the center. We'll use these to help guide or spark our conversations.
- 4. Let's give everyone a chance to share in our discussion.



#### Discussion Time (60 - 90 Mins)

- 1. Use <u>discussion questions</u>
- 2. Share how Jesus has impacted you personally
- 3. Have fun!
