Frequently Asked Questions

What changes are happening at Cultivate this year?

What do you mean by "Regional Representative"?

We acknowledge it's important for regional leadership to be aware of training delivered to Area Directors. As such, we'd like to provide space for one member of each region's leadership. Invitations for this regional representative will be sent to Regional Directors. However, ARDs may attend in their stead.

When does registration close?

Registration closes on Friday, October 10, 2025. We are still requesting an early registration date for an online course to ensure adequate time to complete pre-work.

What is the process for excusing required attendees?

Area Directors should confirm with their Regional Director if they are able to be excused. Upon approval, Regional Directors should email cultivate@intervarsity.org.

I'm on the invitee list but can't attend. Can I give my space to another staff member?

In short, it depends. If you are a "regional representative", yes, because another staff serving in a regional leadership role may attend in your stead. For all other invitees, your space on the invitee list isn't transferable.

I'm an Area Director and I'm in a LeadX staff with Urbana 25. The training overlaps with Cultivate, what should I do?

In partnership with the Urbana team, we have jointly decided that ADs in LeadX should prioritize Cultivate. You will be informed by Urbana on alternate opportunities for you to get caught up on LeadX training.
