Recovering the Lost Art of Relational Evangelism

- "What's your spiritual background? How about today... do you consider yourself a spiritual person now?"
- "What do you like most about our Small Group? How has learning from Jesus impacted your personal values and relationships?" (this is for friends who attend your church sometimes)
- "What do you like most about Jesus? What are some challenges or barriers that might keep you from considering following Jesus?"
- "I'd love to tell you one of my favorite Jesus stories... is that cool?"
- "You would be perfect for our group! We need someone to ask the real questions. Have you ever formed an adult opinion about Jesus?"
- "Thank you for being so honest about what you're going through. I think God could bring important healing to your life. Would you be open to my help?"
- "Have you ever had a helpful wake-up call?"
- "Thank you for trusting me with all the ways that Christians have hurt you and your family. I am so sorry! I think Jesus wants to be with you and your uncle to help heal the pain that religious people have inflicted in Jesus' name.
- "Would it be okay if I pray right now, and we ask Jesus what he would like to say to you?"
- "How satisfied are you with that part of your life? Have you ever considered if God could help you with that?"
